Eligibility and Application Checklist

Thank you for your interest in seeking admission to St. Andrew's School at Wears Valley Ranch. Enclosed you will find the information needed for you to submit a pre-interview application. It is important for you to read the Memorandum of Understanding and the Statement of Faith carefully.

Eligibility

For a child to meet the admission requirements, he or she must be between the ages of 6 and 14 at the time of admission and have an IQ of 80 or higher. Circumstances in the child's home must indicate that he or she will benefit from a change in environment. The child must be willing to work on personal problems.

There are many children in difficult situations, and we want to offer hope and assistance to all. However, the programs at St. Andrews School and Wears Valley Ranch are uniquely suited to children in difficult situations that are not *primarily* the child's fault. We cannot admit children who

- have a drug or alcohol dependency
- are adjudicated delinquents
- are severely emotionally disturbed

If your child does not meet our criteria for admission, we still want to help! There are many other ministries and schools that specialize in helping children with these needs. Please feel free to contact us for a referral.

In Compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (P.L. 88 – 352) no person shall be excluded from the services of St. Andrew's School or Wears Valley Ranch on the grounds of race, color or national origin.

Financial Aid

We DO NOT discriminate because of a student's inability to pay. We DO expect each student's family to support him or her financially to the best of their ability.

Room, Board, and School Tuition is currently \$37,000 annually. Scholarships are available based on need.

Statement of Faith

The Bible

The Bible is God's Word. It contains truth without any mixture of error. We accept its authority over every area of our lives. Through it we come to know God as revealed in the person of Jesus Christ. There are some things in the Bible that we may not fully understand, but as we study we can always learn more.

God

God is the creator of all things. He is perfect, eternal, self-existent, all knowing, all powerful, and present everywhere. He is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He has revealed Himself finally through Jesus the Messiah, Who was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, died on the cross as the full payment for the sins of all who believe, rose from the dead, and is coming again in glory.

Man

Man was created by God for the purpose of serving Him and enjoying fellowship with Him forever. Given the freedom to choose good or evil, our first parents, Adam and Eve, chose evil with the result that suffering and death have passed to every generation in history. All of us demonstrate the effects of this sin in that from our earliest opportunity each of us chooses to disobey God. The consequence is guilt and eternal death.
